Te Whatu Ora – Lakes – Progress on required actions

Lakes DHB underwent an accreditation assessment as a provider of prevocational medical training on 24 and 25 May 2022.

The overall outcome of the assessment for Lakes DHB's accreditation was 'substantially met'.

On 1 July 2022, Te Whatu Ora | Health New Zealand replaced Aotearoa New Zealand's 20 DHBs. The prevocational training programme run by Lakes DHB is now run by Te Whatu Ora – Lakes.

Te Whatu Ora – Lakes is currently accredited for prevocational medical training until 31 August 2027, subject to satisfactorily addressing the required actions listed below.
