

Hutt Valley District Health Board – Progress on required actions

Hutt Valley DHB underwent an accreditation assessment as a provider of prevocational medical training on 12 and 28 October 2020.

The overall outcome of the assessment for Hutt Valley DHB's accreditation was '**substantially met**'.

Hutt Valley DHB is currently accredited for prevocational medical training until 30 April 2025, subject to satisfactorily addressing the required actions listed below.

	Required actions on accreditation	Status	Date of decision
1	The DHB must continue to ensure that interns are allocated to a community-based attachment (CBA) over the course of their 2-year internship and report to Council by 17 December 2021 on the number of their PGY1s and PGY2s who have completed a CBA (Standard 3.1.6)		
2	The DHB must ensure interns participate in a structured afternoon handover (Standard 3.1.9)	Met	8 December 2021
3	The DHB must ensure that interns do not consent for procedures for which they do not have sufficient knowledge (Standard 3.1.10)		
4	Interns must be provided with a structured orientation to each clinical attachment to ensure they are familiar with relevant key staff, systems, policies and processes (Standard 3.4.2)
